Digital child rights for the next 25 years

- ⦿ How can 'Generation Z' reap the benefits of innovations rather than being turned into quantified consumers & monitored citizens?
- ⦿ How do organizations need change to balance long-term transformation with short-term visibility/attention?
- ⦿ How can the development community be involved in setting agendas for the next 25 years of child rights?
